**A RESOLUTION
BY TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE**

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE RENEW ATLANTA INFRASTRUCTURE BOND/TSPLOST PROGRAM'S PRIORITIZED PROJECT LIST; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Resolution 14-R-4373, adopted by the Atlanta City Council on January 5, 2015 and approved by the Mayor on January 6, 2015, called for a Special Election to determine the issuance by the City of Atlanta (“**City**”) General Obligation Public Improvement Bonds to fund up to Two Hundred Fifty Million Dollars and No Cents (\$250,000,000.00) in public improvement capital outlay projects (“**Renew Atlanta Infrastructure Program**”); and

WHEREAS, on March 15, 2015, voters approved the Renew Atlanta Infrastructure Bond Program; and

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of the State of Georgia designated Senate Bill 369 and made effective on April 26, 2016, added a new Part 3 to Article 5A of Chapter 8 of Title 48 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated (“**SB 369**”); and

WHEREAS, SB 369 allows the City, as a metropolitan municipality special district, to impose a Transportation Special Purpose Local Option Sales and Use Tax (“**TSPLOST**”) within the City, for a limited period of time, to fund transportation purposes; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 16-R-3712, adopted by the Atlanta City Council on July 18, 2016 and approved by the Mayor on the same day, the Atlanta City Council approved the TSPLOST and referendum election thereon pursuant to Part 3 of Article 5A of Chapter 8 of Title 48 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, for the sole purpose of funding transportation purposes as defined in SB 369; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 16-R-3712 also set forth a list of the projects and purposes (“**TSPLOST Project List**”) qualifying as “transportation purposes” to be funded from the TSPLOST consistent with the statewide strategic transportation plan; and

WHEREAS, neither the Renew Atlanta Infrastructure Bond Program projects nor the TSPLOST Project List were prioritized at the time of approval; and

WHEREAS, due to the change in market conditions and the rise in construction related costs, it is necessary to prioritize the previously approved Renew Atlanta Infrastructure Bond/TSPLOST Program projects in order to effectively and efficiently maximize the number of projects to be completed throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, the Renew Atlanta Infrastructure Bond/TSPLOST Program held eight (8) public meetings throughout the City to communicate with the public in order to understand which projects contained under the Renew Atlanta Infrastructure Bond Program and the TSPLOST Project List were of the utmost importance to the citizens of Atlanta; and




WHEREAS, based upon those public meetings and other meetings related to the department's prioritization process, the General Manager of the Renew Atlanta Infrastructure Bond/TSPLOST Program recommends that the Prioritized Renew Atlanta/TSPLOST Project List ("**Prioritized Project List**"), attached hereto as Exhibit A be approved; and

WHEREAS, the Prioritized Project List does not reduce funding allocated to each of the 12 Council Districts for local district projects and reserves the outstanding Bond Premium as of 1/1/2019 to support program contingency.

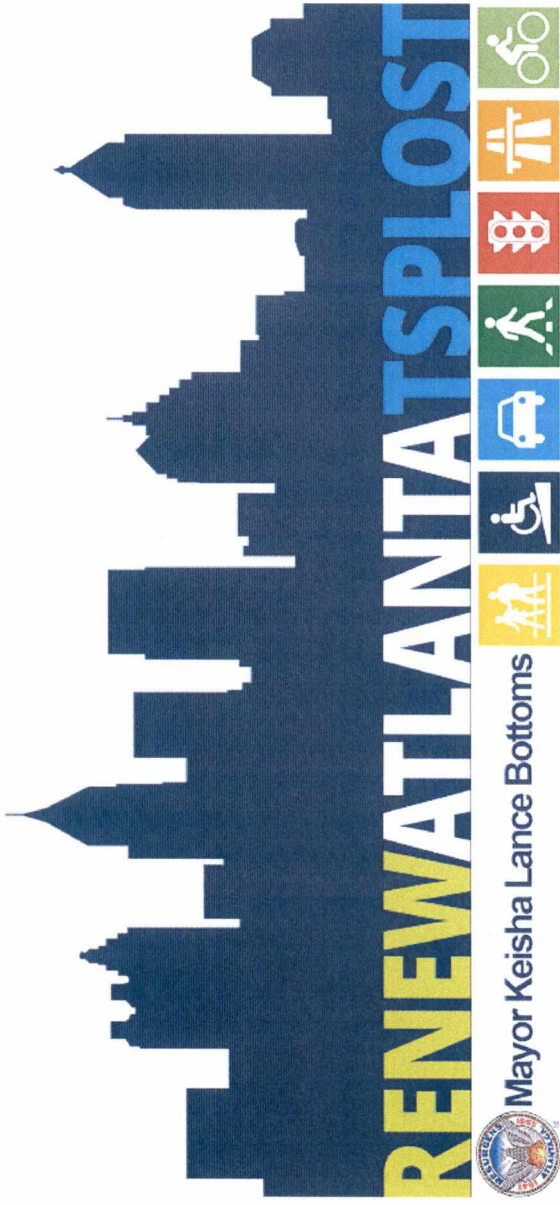
